This permit is for the purpose of transporting animal or fish species which are illegal to import into Alabama, but are to pass through the state in route to a final destination outside the State of Alabama. NOTE: All vehicles and shipping containers are subject to search by law enforcement officers of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

This permit is valid only for the following animals or fish:

This permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All animals and/or fish must be legally obtained and possessed by the permittee.
2. Members of the Cervidae (deer) family must not come from, directly or indirectly, or pass through any state where Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) has been diagnosed.
3. Animals must meet testing requirements of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the State Departments of Agriculture in the originating and destination state. Documentation of negative test results must accompany transport of the animals.
4. The route shall be the most direct possible by state or federal highway.
5. The permittee shall notify the Division at the time of entry into the state and the time of exit at 1-800-272-4263.
6. All trailers or transport containers must be locked and remain locked at all times while in Alabama.
7. Any escapes or releases occurring in Alabama must be reported to the Division immediately.
8. This permit is subject to cancellation at any time and may be subject to the following special conditions, if any:
